A cardiac rehabilitation and prevention program for people at risk for heart disease is offered at Sts. Mary & Elizabeth Hospital as well as at the Garon Lifestyle Center, located on the Jewish Hospital campus. Pulmonary rehabilitation programs are located at Frazier Rehab Institute, adjacent to Jewish Hospital, and at Sts. Mary & Elizabeth Hospital.

Technology

Jewish Hospital & St. Mary's HealthCare has been recognized as a leader in providing the latest medical technology—this is especially true for heart and lung care. Jewish Hospital & St. Mary's HealthCare offers a wide variety of diagnostic services including cardiopulmonary echocardiograms, stress tests, cardiopulmonary stress echos and transesophageal echocardiography. These services, as well as many others, are available at Jewish Hospital, Jewish Hospital Medical Center East, Jewish Hospital Medical Center South, Jewish Hospital Shelbyville, Jewish Hospital Medical Center Southwest and Sts. Mary & Elizabeth Hospital.

The surgical services offered at Jewish Hospital include the full range of catheterization procedures from angioplasty to atherectomy, excimer laser and the use of the cardiac intravascular stent. In addition, dedicated electrophysiology labs focus on conditions involving the heart's electrical system.

Our level of surgical sophistication is also unrivaled in the region. Jewish Heart Care performs all cardiac and thoracic surgeries including heart, lung and heart-lung transplantation. Jewish Hospital is one of only a handful of Centers in the United States to offer a full range of surgical treatments for end-stage heart disease.

Jewish Hospital is also the only facility in the Louisville area to offer state-of-the-art Stereotaxis™ technology in treating heart patients. Stereotaxis is a new technology that boasts patient safety benefits such as shorter, less invasive procedures, less exposure to X-ray radiation, reduction in contrast dyes injected into patient blood vessels and lower risk of complication due to Gentle Touch™ technology.
